He is a specialist in realism for stage and screen using the Methodological approach to acting, and notably in the Yat Malmgren/Laban technique known as Character Analysis or Movement Psychology.

He has introduced the work to a new generation of actors in London, Paris, New York, Los Angeles, Zurich, Berlin, Vienna, Munich, Madrid, Rome, Cairo.

He was recently awarded a special Swiss Film-Academy award for his work as a film-acting coach.

Giles Foreman has worked as an actor, director, writer and producer. He is the founder and director of the Giles Foreman Centre for Acting in London's central Soho district. The centre provides workshops and class-based training for professionals, and post-graduate-level intensive acting courses.

Many actors travel to the centre to prepare for forthcoming film roles.

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
